What is 40 days for Life? It is an international peaceful campaign that combats the evil of abortion through prayer, fasting, peaceful vigil and community outreach. For more information go to 40daysforlife.com.

Where is our local 40 Days for Life Campaign? On the sidewalk in front of the **Wildwood Medical Center building located at 10401 Old Georgetown Rd.** Leroy Carhart's 3rd term Abortion Clinic is located on the 1st floor inside the Wildwood Medical Center.

I have never done anything like this before. God is calling the church to lead the battle to save innocent lives and protect women from the pain, regret and deep emotional wounds caused from having abortions.

What do I need? Bring anything that you would like to pray with. **40 Days for Life Signs** are available to borrow. They are in a bin in front of the home of Christine Ramirez at 5944 Avon Drive behind the Wildwood Medical Center. Help yourself to the business cards with information & phone numbers of local pregnancy centers, post abortion resources and help line phone numbers.

Can I go alone? It is a safe and very busy area. Bring a friend if you can. "When two or three are gathered together in my name, there I am in the midst of them." Matthew 18:20

Where do I park? Park at the Wildwood Baptist Church at 10200 Old Georgetown Rd or on the neighborhood streets behind the Wildwood Medical Center

What if I am unable to make the time I designated to pray? People get sick and unexpected situations happen. Pray to the Holy Spirit for God to send someone in your place.

What do I do? Walk along the sidewalk, outside the white fence on Old Georgetown Rd. Pray for Leroy Carhart, the people that work in the clinic, the women coming to have abortions, the father of the child and their families. Pray the rosary, read the bible, or whatever you feel God is calling you to do. Smile and your peace and joy will be contagious.

Can I bring my children? Bring them if you can pray, watch them and keep them safe. It is a busy street, the goal is to be a peaceful, powerful & positive witness to life!

What should I expect might happen when I am there?

- You will have a peaceful and powerful prayer experience.
- Drivers may honk and wave.
- People might say unkind or offensive things to you. Do not engage or argue with them. Smile & pray for them. This is God's battle not ours. We are being "used" by God to do His work.
- People may ask you questions. Answer with facts or accurate information that you know. Do not make anything up. The best thing to say if you don't know the answer is "I do not know."

What do I do if I feel unsafe? Call 911 if you feel threatened.
