

As a condition of our endorsement by Bishop McGrath of the Diocese of San Jose, he requires us to do the following:

No aggressive or confrontational behavior towards anyone including staff and clients of any abortion facility, counter-demonstrators, and media.

All names and personal information of clients and staff are to be kept confidential.

Placards and displays must be respectful with no graphic displays, condemning words or inflammatory language.

Any activity with the parish, with the parish groups and/or school must be approved by the pastor of the parish.

Any written material to be displayed or circulated other than those already supplied to you by the campaign coordinators, any speakers in a public form, any press releases or requests for interviews by the news media must be approved by Pat Bradley.

In addition, do not park in any public parking lots that are in close proximity to the clinic, including that of Planned Parenthood or the YMCA. There is plenty of on street parking available in the surrounding neighborhood.

Do not use the bathroom facilities of any privately held business such as YMCA. The closest public rest room is at a coffee shop down the street.

Do not block the sidewalk entrances and/or driveway entrances of Planned Parenthood.

Be courteous at all times to the employees and/or volunteers of Planned Parenthood.

Avoid anyone confrontational. Just walk away.

If entering any nearby pro-life pregnancy resource centers, do not carry any signs.

Everyone participating in 40 Days for Life must sign a Statement of Peace which reads:

By signing up to participate in the vigil, you pledge:

I will only pursue peaceful solutions to the violence of abortion when volunteering with the 40 Days for Life campaign

I will show compassion and reflect Christ's love to all abortion facility or Planned Parenthood employees, volunteers, and customers

I understand that acting in a violent or harmful manner immediately and completely disassociates me from the 40 Days for Life campaign

I am in no way associated with Planned Parenthood, its affiliates or any abortion provider

While standing in the public right-of-way at the vigil site:

I will not obstruct the driveways or sidewalk while standing in the public right of way

I will not litter on the public right-of-way

I will closely attend to any children I bring to the prayer vigil

I will not threaten, physically contact, or verbally abuse abortion facility or Planned Parenthood employees, volunteers or customers

I will not damage private property

I will cooperate with local authorities
